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GLOSSARY

BIPOC: Black, Indigenous, and people of color.

Degree-seeking: Students enrolled in courses for credit who are seeking a degree, certificate, or other recognized postsecondary credential.

Estimated Family Contribution Band: The amount of estimated family contribution as determined by FAFSA. The band distinctions change each academic year. The most recent band amounts are:

Pell Range Less than \$6,207

PHEAA Range \$6,207-13,000

Middle Income Range \$13,001-27,000

High Income Range Greater than \$27,000

First Generation: A student whose parents did not complete a four-year college degree

FYFT: First year, First time. This cohort includes only new students who have not attended college before.

Pell grant: Federal grant awarded to undergraduate students who display exceptional financial need.

Residency: State of residence based on a student's permanent home address.
