Jenna Templeton was appointed Vice President of Academic Affairs at Chatham University in 2015, after joining Chatham in 2011 as assistant dean (later dean) of the School of Graduate Studies and the School of Continuing & Professional Studies. In her role as Vice President, she led the University's academic reorganization and curricular revisions as part of the institutional transition to undergraduate coeducation. Her prior work in higher education centered on online education as well as counseling services. She began her career working in alternative educational programs for at-risk youth, providing opportunities for high school diploma completion and job readiness training.
