Chatham Abroad

Students are strongly encouraged to participate in international travel with faculty. Students earn college credits during these trips while they focus on a specific topic within an academic discipline. Past and upcoming trips include South Africa, Belgium, Iceland, Taiwan, and Italy.

SASB Highlights

- Criminology students in the Cold Case Club work with law enforcement professionals on cases that are no longer being actively investigated in affiliation with the Cold Case Investigative Research Institute and the American Investigative Society of Cold Cases.
- Students in the undergraduate and graduate interior architecture programs undertake residencies at Frank Lloyd Wright's iconic Fallingwater residence.
- Undergraduate business students participate in networking events, internships, and competitions with the American Marketing Association (AMA), Project Management Institute (PMI), Pennsylvania Institute for CPAs (PICPA), and Institute for Internal Auditors (IIA).
- Through our award-winning Words Without Walls program, Master of Fine Arts in Creative Writing students teach creative writing to inmates and residents of Allegheny County Jail, State Correctional Institution Pittsburgh, and Sojourner House.
- Over 80% of our Master of Science in Biology students are accepted to medical, dental, veterinary, and Ph.D. programs.
