SBA Announces National Small Business Week Awardees Chatham's Women Business Center Captures National Honors

WASHINGTON – <u>Administrator Linda McMahon</u>, head of the U.S. Small Business Administration, today announced the 2018 National Small Business Week awardees for categories including outreach, contracting, lending, disaster recovery and manufacturing.

Among the winners, Pittsburgh's Chatham University Women's Business Center was lauded as the nation's top women's outreach center.

"Chatham is so deserving of this award. They have a myriad of programs and workshops specifically geared towards women's business ownership and mitigating their unique entrepreneurship obstacles," SBA Pittsburgh District Director Kelly Hunt said. "It's appropriate they were notified in March, which is Women's History Month."

"My goal is to help more of our nation's small business owners be aware of the resources available to them through the SBA. We want more entrepreneurs to think of the SBA as the go-to resource for access to capital, valuable resources, business know-how, and the right expertise for each stage of their business lifecycle.
